Blood Donation Camp (2014-15)

NCC Unit of the Padmashri Vikhe Patil College of Arts, Science and Commerce, Pravaranagar organized the Blood Donation Camp in collaboration with Pravara Medical Trust, Loni at 1st October 2014. In this camp Cadets of NCC Unit, Volunteers of National Service Scheme, Students, Teaching and Non-teaching staff of the college took actively participation for Blood Donation. In this camp total 57 blood bags were collected from NCC cadets.


Doctors from Prayara Medical Trust, Loni told the detail information and benefits of the blood donation in the beginning of the camp. Doctor told the cadets, none may blame you for not participating in the task of completing your social responsibilities, but it is expected that everyone will contribute something towards the formation of a better society, where everyone can live peacefully and happily. Not everyone is really interested in contributing towards the creation of a better society. But there are people that have deep concerns for the overall welfare of the society. They understand the value and significance of blood donation and the importance of blood donation. They donate blood without expecting anything in return. You can see many such people around you that donate blood on a regular basis. The institutions functioning as blood banks do offer to render them some incentives, but what matters to them is the inner happiness they receive by doing the altruistic deed, like donating blood. Before you give blood, you'll first have to complete a quick physical that measures your temperature, pulse, blood pressure, and hemoglobin levels. After your blood is collected, it's sent off to a lab where it will undergo 13 different tests for infectious diseases, like HIV and West Nile virus. If anything comes back positive, you'll be notified immediately. Donating blood is one way to get a free blood test. During the donation process, people are screened to determine if they are healthy enough to give blood and if they have any blood pressure problems or infections. The blood is also tested after donation to ensure it is safe to be given to another person. After giving blood, donors can ask to be notified if there are any irregularities in their blood, which can save them a visit to the doctor's office and, perhaps, even a medical bill. A sixty-three-year-old grandmother in the United Kingdom was in the process of donating blood when the preliminary screening process detected irregularities. It turned out she had bowel cancer, which doctors detected at an early stage because of her blood screening test.



During this camp Principal Dr. S. R. Walunj told that, not all people are aware of the blood donation facts and hence know very little about the health benefits of blood donation. You may receive material incentives and rewards, inner joy and happiness, but what you receive in addition, is the health benefits. Many people may not desire inner joy or material incentives, and yet they donate blood as they are more health conscious. They are well aware of how donating blood can help them to remain healthy.

There is a reason why the World Health Organization describes blood donation as "the most precious gift anyone can give to another person": one sample of donated blood can save up to three lives. However, blood donation does not benefit only those who receive the blood. Donors also experience a number of benefits.
